September 27th-October 5th

Why is this week so important?

According to the 2024 Military Family Lifestyle Survey, only 39% of active-duty respondents feel a sense of belonging to their local civilian community. The average military family moves three times as often as their civilian peers. And while more than 70% of families live off of the military installation in their local civilian communities, they do not feel a strong sense of belonging to those communities.

Why are Blue Star Welcome Week partners needed?

Blue Star Welcome Week is how we get upstream of the lack-of-belonging problem and help our military families thrive. We know that if you can create a moment of welcome when people move, everything else improves — financial challenges, mental and physical health, and so much more! Together, we can turn this moment into a movement and empower military families to feel a greater sense of belonging to the community in which they live and serve.
